- 1. Deanne Sanville requested a driveway permit location change to 100' north; FE, HS and RV were familiar with the site; Motion FE/MA to approve change to Cold Pond Road driveway permit, passed. There was also discussion about closing the Shaw Hill Road driveway to the lot DS merged with her Cold Pond Road lot.
