

## **Highway Dept Report**

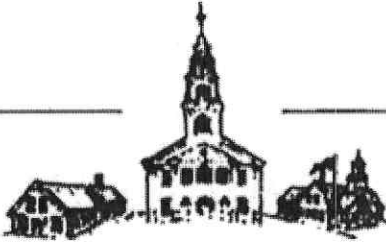

### **Current Work**

- Packed the Transfer Station twice weekly (Mondays and Thursdays)
  - Cleaned and organized the office and shop
  - Washed and cleaned trucks and equipment
    - Greased trucks and equipment
    - Attended FEMA meetings.
    - Worked on Sam Putnam Rd
    - Graded Sam Putnam Road
- Graded Turkey Shoot Road and the Class V section of Old Caremont Road
  - Graded Grout Road, Lynn Road, and John Symons Road
  - Completed culvert replacement on Allen Road
- Performed site cleanup on Allen Road following culvert replacement
- Met with Ben from Fuzzy Brothers to discuss culvert replacements on Heino Road and Sam Putnam Road
  - Completed the DES report for the Allen Road culvert repair
  - Meeting with DOT about 4 way stop at Beryl/Hill/123A
  - Met with DES about Grout Hill Bridge repair/ permit

- Inspect and clean culverts townwide
  - Inspect box culverts
- Implement road maintenance plan
- Forest Road culvert replacement underway, pending DES permit approval
  - Grade roads as needed
  - Perform ditching operations
- Conduct brush cleanup townwide
  - Patch potholes townwide
  - Sweep bridge decks
- Complete roadwork on Sam Putnam Road to reopen the road
  - Roadside mowing townwide
