

I'm very pleased to share this article that has been picked up by several news agencies regarding our broadband effort. I'm working closely with NHEC on their communications. The new information in this announcement is that we (Acworth) have signed an "agreement for cooperation" to work with NHEC to enable broadband fiber optics in our town!!! The schedule remains the same. Construction will occur this year with some homes being enabled by the end of the year. The bulk of the homes being enabled will be in Q1 of 2022. NHEC is still working on details regarding the schedule. I will share information as soon as I receive it. The entry level monthly service cost remains at \$49.99 however the entry level service has increased from 25/25 mbps to 100/100 mbps !!! (Reminder that most of us are on 7/1 mbps with some of us at 11/1 mbps). The cost to the town remains at \$0.
