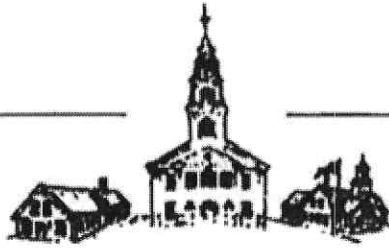
15 June – 25 June 2026

Current Work

- Packed the Transfer Station twice weekly (Mondays and Thursdays)
 - Cleaned and organized the office and shop
 - Washed and cleaned trucks and equipment
 - Greased trucks and equipment
 - Attended FEMA meetings.
 - Pot hole patching work on Alan Rd & Cold Pond Rd
 - Performed roadside mowing along Beryl Mountain Rd
- Disassembled the sweeper and completed necessary repairs
- Cleared and cleaned up downed trees following the storm
 - Repaired culvert on Lufkin Loop
- Performed maintenance and repairs on the roadside mower
- Performed maintenance at the transfer station and placed a waste block behind the compactor
 - Inspected culverts townwide
 - Monitored beaver dams
- Established a new system to monitor driveway culverts
 - Worked on driveway permit applications – for PB

- Continue culvert inventory
- Inspect and clean culverts townwide
 - Inspect box culverts
- Implement road maintenance plan
- Forest Road culvert replacement -3 culverts remaining (pending DES approval)
 - Grade roads as needed
 - Perform ditching operations
 - Conduct brush cleanup townwide
 - Patch potholes townwide
- Sweep bridge decks
- Roadside mowing townwide
- More coldpatching on Alan Rd, Cold Pond Rd, Crescent Lake Rd
 - Site Visit with BETA on Crescent Lake Rd
