Current Work

- Packed the Transfer Station twice weekly (Mondays and Thursdays)
 - Cleaned and organized the office and shop
 - Washed and cleaned trucks and equipment
 - Greased trucks and equipment
 - Attended FEMA meetings
 - Graded Gove Road
 - Graded Heino Rd
 - Cleaned the yard and gravel pit
 - Forest Road culvert replacement work
 - Applied cold patch on Crescent Lake Road
- Traveled to Londonderry to pick up excavator parts
 - Addressed mud issues on Gove Road
- Removed plow frames and wings and stored them for the winter season
 - Performed shop work
 - Completed floor work in the shop
 - Met with the crack sealing crew
- Removed road work signage from Forest Road
- Conducted site assessments of Forest Road and Charlestown Road properties in support of installation of driveway culverts for applications to Planning Board for their meeting on April 25.
- **Crescent Lake Road sweeping:** Removed 51 cubic yards of sand (three 10-wheeler loads), compared to 6 cubic yards removed last year from three one-ton loads.
 - Cleaned up downed tree on Beryl Mountain Rd
 - Deep clean and organization of the office and shop

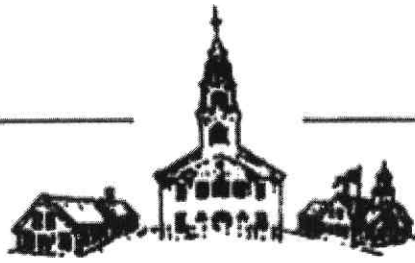
Upcoming Work
