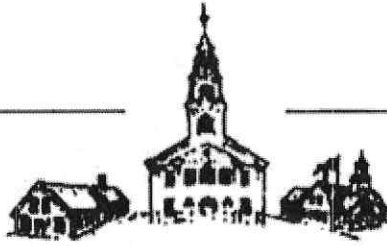

Current Work

- Packed the Transfer Station twice weekly (Mondays and Thursdays)
 - Cleaned and organized the office and shop
 - Washed and cleaned trucks and equipment
 - Greased trucks and equipment
 - Attended FEMA meetings.
 - Worked on Sam Putnam Rd
 - Removed a fallen tree on Beryl Mountain Road
 - Graded Forest Road and Livermore Road
 - Graded Bascom Hill Road
 - Performed maintenance on the roadside mower
 - Applied grease to the Freightliner
 - Cleaned and greased the grader
 - Graded Heino Road and repaired potholes
 - Inspected the sinkhole on Alan Road
- Submitted emergency shoreline permit for Alan Road repairs
- Filed permit for culvert replacement on Sam Putnam Road
 - Conducted maintenance on trucks
 - Participated in a class about bridge posting
 - Attended training on pavement maintenance
- Met with Jeff from Basin Brothers regarding a late July to early August start for the Derry Hill project
 - Coordinated with Josh regarding the upcoming culvert repair on Cold Pond Road
- Coordinating with Springfield Paving to confirm a mid-to late-June start date for the Cold Pond shim and overlay project.

 - Sweep bridge decks
- Complete roadwork on Sam Putnam Road to reopen the road
 - Roadside mowing townwide
