## Board of Selectmen Meeting: March 20, 2017

### **Recognition of Visitors/Public Input:**

1. Jim Grenier described recent proceedings in State legislature noting his opposition to right to work legislation which he found anti-family and State worker and no carry permitting which he noted police wanted to keep. JG noted his ongoing position to vote for legislation which brings money into towns, that there is a chance some revenue sharing will be revived and that there is no State money for roads. He noted his objection to the State's reduction of Stabilization Grants. These grants lower towns' education costs and could eventually be phased out altogether shifting more education funding costs to towns.

**Transfer Station Report:** DG noted Carl York has had to resign as attendant for health reasons. There was discussion regarding the need for candidates. FE inquired whether Charlie Bradt would consider the position and he said he would. There was consensus CB would meet with FE and DG at the Transfer Station.

### **Highway Department Report:**

1. Work update/plan: EB described recent equipment failures including 3500 CV joint, 250 alternator and 550 turbo charger. If winter maintenance allows crew will work on shur pac filling potholes.
2. Allen Road Bridge: EB noted progress. Engineer report noted minor plan change; need to inquire whether this requires cost change.
3. Nelson Road plowing: Motion FE/DG to sign letter to owner with release pending Town Meeting vote on road.
4. Grader search: Revisit April 3.
5. Bob Stocker and David Huffling will clear walks as needed for season remainder.
6. Bowers Brook Bridge replacement: EB noted need to address detour routes this year for 2018 bridge closure during replacement.

**ConCom Report:** DG noted monitoring planning. Motion DG/FE to sign request for green up day trash bags, passed.
