- 1. Jereme Burdick: Class 6 Black North Road building permit application: It was noted that the Board is required by statute to review building permit applications on Class 6 roads and that the Board has previously issued a driveway permit for this property and is familiar with the location. Motion FE/MG to return the application to the Selectmen for permit issue, passed.
- 2. Gregg Thibodeau: the Catalyst grant application being developed for paving of Cold Pond Road includes a description of the Town's process for sustaining the work of such projects. It was noted that certain routine maintenance tasks are covered annually under the Selectmen's recommended operating budget as Highway Maintenance: Crack Sealing and Pothole Repair and that surface treatment is covered as needed under the Planning Board's recommended capital improvements.
